Change-of-Coverage Periods

Fall Term: Sept. 4 - 25, 2025

Winter Term (new students only): Jan. 5 - 23, 2026

Spring Term (new students only): May 4 - 25, 2026

If you're eligible, the fees for the Plan are automatically included in your tuition and other fees. During the applicable period above, you can change your coverage, enrol your family, or opt out of the Plan if you have proof of other coverage. Some students may also be eligible to enrol themselves in the Plan.
