





How much does it cost?

The cost of the Plan and the Legal Care Program (The Essentials) is part of your student association-administered fees. You're responsible for verifying if you're automatically covered by the Plan and if you have access to the Program by checking your tuition statement.

Winter Term (new students only): Jan. 5 - 23, 2026


Spring Term (only new students and co-op students who weren't on academic term in Fall Term or Winter Term): May 11 - June 1, 2026

If you're eligible, the fees for the Plan and the Legal Care Program (The Essentials) are automatically included in your tuition and other fees.

During the applicable period, you can change your Plan coverage, enrol your family in the Plan, or opt out of these services (you must have proof of other coverage to opt out of the health portion of the Plan). Some students may also be eligible to enrol themselves in the Plan. See www.studentcare.ca for instructions.
