This service offers online registration and appointments. Consultations are offered in many languages and can be done via video calls through Dialogue's platform, ensuring confidentiality and flexibility.

Get support for issues of any kind, such as:



Mental health: Talk to mental health specialists about what's on your mind.



Career & work: Get advice on career planning, CVs, and recommendation letters.



Family & Relationships: Ask for help if you are experiencing difficulties or conflicts with your family or relationships.



Finances: talk to a financial planner to find out more about managing a budget, debts, savings, etc.



Nutrition: get nutritional advice from a team of registered dietitians.
